

Hickory Swing Thursday Night Men's League Rules

This is a fun league & we want to keep it that way while still playing by the rules.

League Play starts at 6:00 (5:45 for the first two weeks) and players are asked to play ready golf.

A player cannot improve their lie unless it's ground under repair, casual water, etc.

Out of Bounds Rule: A ball hit out of bounds will be dropped within two club lengths from where it crossed the out of bounds line and the player will take a one stroke penalty. The net on #13 is out of bounds, there will be a drop area available but you must take a one stroke penalty.

Lost Ball Rule: No more than 3 minutes to look for a lost ball. If a player cannot find their ball the two players with-in the match can decide where to drop a new ball with a one stroke penalty.

Maximum strokes a player can take on a par three is **6** and on a par four is **8**.

Please write all players first & last name legibly on scorecards and sign-in sheets. Turn in signed and calculated scorecards to the clubhouse immediately after play. Players in each match must calculate score and points. No changes will be made once each player signs off on the agreed points and scores.

Weekly fee is \$14.00 per player or \$3.00 if a player has a season pass. \$5.00 a night for private carts or no charge with a yearly trail fee. Teams can have a standing reservation for a rental cart.

Play will be in groups of 8.

Ace Pot: \$25.00 per team 75% goes to first person to make a hole in hole. Then pot starts over.

No Show Rule: When a team or a player does not show the opposing team will receive 7 points per no-show. Any scores against a no-show will not count towards handicap. If a player is more than two holes they forfeit the match, otherwise they take the max score for holes missed.

No-shows will still be required to pay full price for nights missed before they/team can play again.

Dark Rule: If play is stopped by darkness with 1 or 2 holes remaining, each team will take par for the remaining holes and split the points. **Weather Rule:** If play is shortened due to weather, points will count for holes completed. The rest of the points for holes not completed will be halved. The night will count as an official point night but the scores will not go towards handicap. If the horn is blown the players may only finish the hole they are on.

State law says that All alcohol consumed on Hickory Swing's property must be purchased from Hickory Swing. If a player is caught bringing alcohol onto the property their entire team forfeits their points.
